## SUMMER 2017 PRE-DECISION APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 8, 2017

All applicants are required to attend a Learning Abroad 101 session before submitting an application. Applications are not considered for admission until the pre-decision application packet, personal statement, and initial payment

are completed and submitted. Late applications are subject to a \$100 penalty and are considered on a case-by-case basis. Once you have submitted the application materials and the deadline has passed, applications are reviewed by Faculty Directors and Learning Abroad. **Students will be notified by Learning Abroad through Umail of their application status.**
