EXCEPT for official transcripts, which must be mailed to 200 S. Central Campus Drive, Union 159, Salt Lake City, Utah, 84112

- Personal Statement (a one-page, single spaced essay describing the student's academic goals and motivations for participating in the exchange program)
- Official letter of nomination from home institution
- Mail official transcripts (paper copy) from any institutions attended, including those listed in Question #12 (page 2)
- Color copy of the identification and signature pages of your passport
- Copy of language proficiency scores
 - TOEFL minimum 80iBT/IELTS minimum: 6.5
- Home Institution Application Verification form signed by your home institution exchange coordinator
- Source and proof of finances (proof of \$9,400.00 per semester of stay).
 - If the student is supporting themselves, include an official bank statement
 - Bank statements should have your name on the account
 - If the student has a sponsor, include the sponsor's bank statement and affidavit of support
 - Bank statements should have the student sponsor's name on the account
